WHAT IS FIRST SOUND FLUENCY?

The DIBELS Next First Sound Fluency (FSF) is a brief direct measure of a student's fluency in identifying the initial sounds in words This is a revision of the Initial Sound Fluency (ISF) measure and is administered, like all other DIBELS Next measures, in one minute The ability to isolate the first sound in a word is an important phonemic

First Sound Fluency • The understanding that words are made up of separate sounds is called “phonemic awareness” Phonemic awareness is a critical skill in learning to read The FSF subtest assesses your child's ability to isolate the beginning sounds in words Your child is given a word and asked to say the first sound in the word

HANDOUT-ABLE: Summary of Stuttering Modification/Fluency ...

Fluency-enhancing techniques are attempts at promoting fluency in a generalized way: Light contact = producing the initial sounds of words that are plosives in manner — /b, p, d, t, g, k/ — these sounds are produced very gently Light productions improve fluency due to less tension being involved
