From 1993-1994 through 2012-2013, more medical students left medical school for nonacademic than for academic reasons, according to data reported by medical school registrars in the AAMC Student Records System (SRS) The total national attrition rate remained relatively stable at an average of 33% over those 20 years

compared to all United States medical school applicant: MCAT scores had little relationship with student's success" It appears that the performance on any type of post-bac or pre-medical school preparatory program is a better predictors of success in medical school than the MCAT score
