Rules for Riding a Bicycle on the Road

riding a bicycle have the same rights, duties, and responsibilities as vehicle drivers In the absence of special markings or directions—and the specific situations outlined below—people biking must ride in the direction of traffic and as near to the right side of the travel lane as is safe

Guide to Safe Bicycling

Riding on the right doesn't mean hugging the curb or edge of the road It means riding as far right as practicable and still being safe from obstacles, debris and traffic When to take a lane A bicyclist may take the travel lane in the following situations: • If traveling the same speed as other traffic • When passing another vehicle

BICYCLING ON SIDEWALKS

Rather like the situation with riding the wrong way against traffic, there is no specific crash type reserved for bicyclists riding on the sidewalk However, the fact that the bicyclist was on the sidewalk is a contributing factor in a great many crashes at intersections

Yes, cyclists have to obey traffic laws According to the DC Municipal Regulations, Title 18, Section 12011, Every person riding a bicycle on a highway shall be subject to all the duties applicable to the drivers of motor vehicles under this title, except as otherwise

CHICAGO MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING BICYCLES

(a) Every person riding a bicycle upon a roadway shall be granted all of the rights and shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle by the laws of this state declaring rules of the road applicable to vehicles or by the traffic ordinances

13 AAC 02400 Riding Bicycles On Roadways And Bicycle Paths b) Persons riding bicycles on a roadway may not ride more than two abreast except on paths or parts of roadways set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles Persons riding bicycles two abreast may not impede traffic and, in a laned roadway, shall ride within the farthest right lane
