Basic Management Plan for Care Under Fire 1 Return fire and take cover 2 Direct or expect casualty to remain engaged as a combatant if appropriate 3 Direct casualty to move to cover and apply self-aid if able 4 Try to keep the casualty from sustaining additional wounds 5
