the mean serum VEGF concentration is significantly lower than in healthy controls and the lower the VEGF level the higher the risk for Alzheimer's disease [6] Results of research with rodents indicate that VEGF expression in the hippocampus is a mediator of the effects of the environment on neurogenesis and cognition, learning and memory [7,8]
